At least 12 credits must be earned during the doctoral program. For this purpose, you will attend compulsory modules (total 9 credits) and elective modules (minimum 3 credits).

Attendance of the PhD seminar is mandatory for the entire duration of the doctorate.

- ** If the certificate GCP 3 (or equivalent) has already been acquired, the module does not have to be completed again and can be replaced by an elective module. To receive 1 ECTS, both GCP 3 and the Journal Club must be taken.
