At least 12 ECTS must be earned during the doctoral program. For this purpose, you will attend compulsory modules (total 9 ECTS) and elective modules (minimum 3 ECTS).

Attendance of the PhD seminar is mandatory for the entire duration of the doctorate.

- ** If the certificate GCP 3 (or equivalent) has already been acquired, the module does not have to be completed again and can be replaced by an elective module. To receive 1 ECTS, both GCP 3 and a Journal Club must be taken.
- ** Two Journal Clubs are offered: The Joint Journal Club with Karolinska Institutet in Stockholm (focusing on the health sector) and the Journal Club of the Graduate Campus of UZH. For registration contact the program coordinator. If the two Journal Clubs are combined, 1 ECTS can be credited.
